

# FOUND A SICK OR INJURED PENGUIN?

Have you found a kororā (little blue penguin) out in the open during daylight hours?

If so, it may be in distress, starving, sick or injured and in need of help. Acting quickly can make a significant difference to the bird's survival. You can support wildlife conservation efforts by following these steps.

**If the kororā is alive:**

1. Keep people and dogs away to minimise stress to the bird.
2. Call us on 0800 SICK PENGUIN (0800-742-573).
3. Stay calm and quiet, share your exact location over the phone, and follow all further instructions.

*If you cannot reach us, call ARRC Wildlife Vets (07-579-9115). If you cannot reach ARRC or are outside of the Western Bay of Plenty, call the Department of Conservation on 0800 DOC HOT (0800-362-468).*

**If the kororā is dead, please:**

1. Take a photo and log your finding on the iNaturalist app ([www.iNaturalist.org](http://www.iNaturalist.org)).
2. Send us an email with the photo, time and exact location ([westernbaywildlife@gmail.com](mailto:westernbaywildlife@gmail.com)).

**For other native wildlife:** call ARRC Wildlife Vets (07-579-9115) or Department of Conservation on 0800 DOC HOT (0800-362-468) and follow their instructions.
